#### **About Mauritius and the Characters**

Chief among the participants in this battle for control are the feisty, life-bruised Jackie, and the seemingly genteel Mary; half-sisters who have nothing in common but a newly dead mother who left a stamp collection for them to fight over.

Within the collection lies a fortune in the form of two of the world's rarest stamps. Jackie aims to sell it and clear her debts; Mary, however, has no intention of letting them go.

Then there's the triumvirate of stamp-loving men with whom the sisters become embroiled: Philip, who runs a dusty philately shop; Dennis, an oily-tongued dude of indeterminate employment; and Sterling, an ophidian fellow with a hair-trigger temper and enough money to buy whatever he wants.
